Charlottesville Area Transit (CAT) passengers will continue to ride **fare-free until June 30, 2026** in the City of Charlottesville and portions of urban Albemarle County. All CAT buses are accessible to persons with disabilities and are wheelchair lift-equipped.

Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Paratransit Services

ADA Complementary Paratransit Service is available to individuals with disabilities who cannot otherwise access CAT's fixed-route service. ADA Paratransit is a shared ride; advance reservation, origin-to-destination service provided by JAUNT on behalf of CAT. Passengers may use the service to travel to destinations within a ¾ mile-radius of CAT's fixed-route service. ADA applications may be picked up at the Downtown Transit Station on Tuesdays & Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Jaunt provides curb-to-curb demand-response service in the counties of Buckingham, Fluvanna, Louisa, Nelson and rural Albemarle. Provides ADA paratransit service in the City of Charlottesville and urban Albemarle. Pre-approval by a Charlottesville Area Transit (CAT) representative is required to use Jaunt's ADA paratransit service.

This service transports commuters from park and ride lots to locations at UVA and downtown Charlottesville in the morning, returning in the evening. 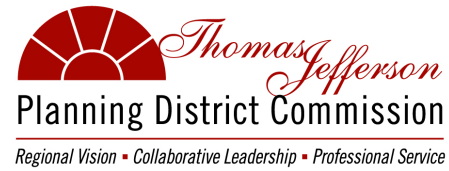
